Hello Paul,

I have done extensive research on the Greek Catholic church records from Svidnik--extracted from LDS film records. Your Miga roots in Svidnik very clearly

state that they were from Kapisova, originally. Have Birth Records for :

Joseph,

Jan. 03, 07, 1870, born to Michael Miga and Helena Juhaszcsik, (Also Svidnik). One Godparent was a Stefanczo. Have Joseph's death record, listed as Feb. 10, 1870, at Also Svidnik 18.

Anna was born to these same parents Jan. 28, 29, 1871--Godparents were John Stefanczo and Anna Szavko.

Juliana was born to these same parents, Mar. 03, 07, 1884--Godparents were

Michael Kurilecz and Anna Szavko. Parents were cited at Also Svidnik 23, by then.

Marriage records:

Michael Miga, 25, (Born ~ 1844), son of the dead Andras, from Kapisova, and

Helena Juhaszcsik, 20, (Born ~ 1849, dghtr of Andreas, at Also Svidnik 18, Married Feb. 08, 1869. Witnesses were Michael Szavko, Michael Ruzinko and Andreas Szimko.

Vazul Miga, 34, (Born ~ 1874, and also by then, a widower), Felso Fenyés, and

Maria Kocsan, 30, (Born ~ 1878, and by then also a widow), Felso Viszkoz. Married Feb. 03, 1908. Witnesses were Janos Motily and Siman Kocsan.

Janos Miga, age--(from Kapisova, son of Istvan Miga and Paraszka Vaszilenko) and Anna Kurilecz, age--(from Also Viszkoz, dghtr of Andras. Married Nov. 09, 1919. Witnesses were Andrej Ju---- and Andrej Baran, both from Kapisova.

Good luck in your quest--they are there and we can find them!
